THE ACTIVITY

Nihon Tai Jitsu is a martial art with Japanese origins and philosophy, but with a Western conception. It is one of the most **effective methods of self-defense**.

The classes have a high pedagogical and participatory content, focusing on martial technical aspects (basic techniques, katas, kihon waza, and self-defense) based on bushido (the ethical code of martial arts that promotes respect, justice, and fairness).

Students will improve their concentration, energy management, and human values.

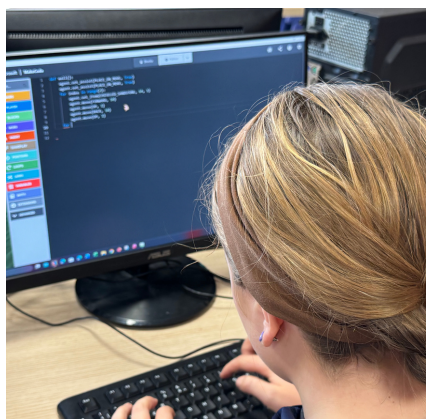
